Iowa Chapter of the American Fisheries Society Iowa State University Undergraduate Scholarship

Essential selection criteria:

A junior or senior in the Fisheries or Aquaculture option with a major in Animal Ecology, Iowa State University.

A student who has at least average grades.

At least one summer of field experience in fisheries or aquaculture or other experience judged to be relevant to a career in fisheries or aquaculture.

Membership in the American Fisheries Society or the Iowa Chapter of the American Fisheries Society is required.

Additional criteria:

The Scholarship Committee may use other relevant work or professionally relevant experience in the selection process if no candidate meets the above work experience and membership requirements.

The candidates will submit an essay of not less than 500 words describing their field experience in fisheries or aquaculture.

Involvement in Iowa Chapter of the American Fisheries Society activities is a desirable attribute of a scholarship recipient.

Other:

The award shall be in the form of tuition remuneration, not cash.

The Scholarship Committee does not have to make a selection when they determine that the student candidate pool does not have deserving individuals.

Students may be asked to apply for the scholarship or the recipient may be selected by the scholarship committee from the list of students in the Fisheries or Aquaculture options.
